Guidelines

The IAA is pleased to offer continuing educational scholarships to current IAA members in good standing who have paid membership dues and have been paid members of IAA for over one calendar year and conducts a majority of their practice in Indiana.

- Funds may be used to attend local, state, or national conferences.
- Preference is given to members who have not previously received an educational scholarship from IAA.
- A member can receive funds only once per calendar year.

To request funds:

Please allow the IAA Award Committee up to 10 days to review and respond to your request.

Details:

- Those awarded a scholarship will be notified by the Award Committee Chair.
- The scholarship recipient will pay all expenses and reimbursement will be available after expense review by the committee.
- Up to \$500.00 of expenses may be covered. No financial match is required. Allowable expenses are conference registration (no side trips or special conference package trips), lodging, and round-trip transportation (airfare or mileage at the current IRS rates, and shuttle from airport to conference center. Meals and car rental are not included.
- After attending the event, the awardee is required to send (within 10 days after the event) all original receipts to the IAA address listed above:
 - o Lodging, travel, and shuttle receipts indicating date and place (no receipt, no reimbursement)
 - o An agenda of the conference with registration paid receipt and the attended sessions highlighted.
 - Recipients are expected to share pertinent ideas gleaned from the conference that may be of interest to the IAA membership. This may be done via a written summary to the IAA Board of Directors or an article for the *Hoosier Arborist*.
